



COMPETITION RULES

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- **1.-** The Contest will be held on Friday, January 27th at 5:30 p.m. in Recinto Feiral de Silleda.
- **2.-** Before the Competition, a Demonstration of Showmanship will be held for all present and especially for the participants in this Contest.
- **3.-** It may participate individually, all young people of any country and whose age does not exceed 30 years, including.
- **4.-** Given the age difference between the possible participants, the sections are established as indicated in point 5.

5.- SECTIONS:

Section 1: Young people between 21 and 30 years old will compete.

Section 2: Young people between the ages of 16 and 20 will compete.

Section 3: Includes youths between the ages of 10 and 15 inclusive.

Section 4: Young people under the age of 9 will participate.

Section 5: CHAMPIONSHIP: The first three classified in sections 1, 2 and 3 will compete for the titles of CHAMPION, SUBCAMPEÓN and MENTION OF HONOR.

- **6.-** The sections will be judged beginning with the older Showman, thus allowing the younger ones to learn the techniques that older ones use.
- **7.-** In the event that any section has less than 3 participants, they will be included in the previous or later section, depending on their age.
- **8.-** It will be taken as the reference date to determine the age of the contestants on December 31, 2016.
- **9.-** Being the objective of the contest, to train and encourage young people in the tasks of tame, handling and presentation of livestock, each participant will be obliged to prepare the animal with which to compete.
- **10.-** The younger ones may be assisted in the work mentioned above (point 9) by their parents, collaborators of the Club or other persons that are in the enclosure.

11.- Contestants must participate, with animals registered in the sections of calves or heifers of the Regional and / or International Competition.

PRESENTATION CONDITIONS

By the time of presentation of the animals on the ring, each driver must:

- **12.-** Obligatorily, go in uniform with **WHITE SHIRT AND TROUSERS.**
- **13.-** Check that the animal who is going to be exhibited is perfectly tamed, clean and in conditions to go on the ring.
- **14.-** Be attentive to the instructions that are given and presented punctually on the ring, when and how many times it is required.
- **15.-** Once on the ring, be attentive at all times, to the indications of the judge and to act, correctly and quickly, according to them.
- **16.-** Keep the animal under control at all times, taking care not to distract or disturb the other contestants.
- **17.-** Be prepared to answer any questions the judge may ask about the animal you are driving (age, country, etc).
- **18.-** Remember that a section has not ended until the judge indicates it, therefore, any placement will be provisional until that moment.
- **19.-** Accepting and assuming sporty the decisions of the judge, maintaining at all times a correct and respectful attitude both with the Judge and with the partners.

JUDGMENT

The judging of the Young Showman Contest will be handled by the International Judge responsible for the contest.

They will be missions of this judge:

- **20.-** Evaluate the skills of the handlers (tame and presentation) without taking into account the morphological characteristics of the animals presented.
- 21.- Judge each section separately.
- **22.-** Give explanations of the reason of the placement in each section judged, seeking to advise young people how to improve their technique.

- **23.-** Proceed to the final placement of the handlers, taking into account the three basic premises that they must observe (preparation of the animal, technique of presentation and attitude demonstrated on the ring, both towards his companions and the indications of the judge).
- **24.-** The decisions of the judge are unappealable, therefore, the participation implies the acceptance of the same.

AWARDS

- **25.-** Rosettes will be awarded to the first 3 classified in sections 1, 2 and 3.
- **26.-** Section 4: young people under 9 years old: a rosette and a gift will be granted to all participants.
- **27.-** In the Championship (section 5), the following prizes will be awarded:

Champion: €150 and trophy

Runner-up: €100

Honorable Mention: €80

4th place: € 60 5th place: € 40 6th place: €20

FINAL PROVISIONS

- **28.-** Participation implies the acceptance of all the rules contained in these regulations.
- **29.-** During the event, photographs will be taken of both the participants and any other person attending the event, which may be published later on the website of the organizers, brochures, magazines, newspapers or other media with the purpose of spreading the acts, activities and events that they carry out. The rights of access, rectification, cancellation and opposition can be exercised at all times, addressing the Federacion Frisona Galega, Fundación Semana Verde and Clube de Xóvenes Gandeiros de Galicia, attaching a photocopy of your ID.
- **30.-** In the case of minors, paternal authorization implies the acceptance, and for all effects, of the provisions in the previous point (29).
- **31.-** The organizing committee shall decide on any questions that may arise in the interpretation of the regulation, or that are not included therein.
